1 **ISSUING AGENCY:** Children, Youth and Families Department (CYFD)

2 SCOPE: Juvenile Justice Services (JJS)

5 APPLICABLE POLICY: NMAC 8.14.4.15 Fifteen Day Diagnostics: describes the process for completing court-ordered diagnostic evaluations.

- 8. 15-Day Diagnostic Evaluations: CYFD ensures that clients who are committed to undergo a 15-day diagnostic evaluation, pursuant to Section 32A-2-17(D) of the Delinquency Act, receive a comprehensive diagnostic evaluation. A written report of the results of the diagnostic evaluation is provided to the court.
 - 8.1 CYFD provides, contracts for, or otherwise arranges 15-day diagnostic evaluations of youth when ordered by the court.
 - 8.2 Within 12 days of the referral, the qualified diagnostician completes a Psychological Evaluation.
 - 8.3 The Psychological Evaluation is a comprehensive report that is submitted to the court and includes diagnosis, level of functioning, and recommendations.
 - 8.3.1 The qualified CYFD diagnostician or contractor collects the following information:
 - 8.3.1.1 clinical interview with the client;
 - 8.3.1.2 assessment using psychological tests, screening instruments, rating scales, intelligence tests, or any other standardized assessment instrument that has been approved for use by the Behavioral Health Authority for 15-Day Diagnostic Evaluations;
 - 8.3.1.3 review of collateral information;
 - 8.3.1.4 interviews with key staff, family members and/or legal guardians.
 - 8.4 Within 12 days of client referral for diagnostic evaluation, a qualified medical professional completes the Medical Report.
 - 8.4.1 The qualified medical health professional collects the following information:
 - 8.4.1.1 client health history;
 - 8.4.1.2 medication history;
 - 8.4.1.3 physician and psychiatrist orders.
 - 8.5 Within 12 days of diagnostic client referral, a qualified education staff member completes the Education Report.

- 8.5.1 The qualified education staff member collects the following information:
 - 8.5.1.1 general academic screening;
 - 8.5.1.2 review of collateral educational records;
 - 8.5.1.2.1 Education Reports cannot include level of function and diagnosis if the client is receiving special education services without documented consent;
 - 8.5.1.3 hearing screening results.
- 8.6 Reports that are completed by CYFD staff are submitted for approval to the appropriate supervisor by the day following referral.
- 8.7 The reports are:
 - 8.7.1 faxed to the client's JPPO: the original report is mailed to the judge.
